Judging Procedure

All applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of the Reeve, or designate, the Lamont County Manager and the Lamont County Executive Secretary. No immediate family members of applicants shall sit on this committee. The successful candidates will be selected based upon a combination of the following criteria:

- citizenship and rural community involvement
- extra-curricular activities
- individual letter of application
- financial need
- academic performance
- career goals
- employment history

Note: whilst academic performance is important, it will not be the most important criteria governing this award.

Presentation of the Award

Upon receipt by Lamont County of confirmation of registration at a recognized Alberta post-secondary institution, the successful candidates is required to attend a meeting of County Council where they will be awarded a cheque in the amount of \$1,000.
