

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITYSeasonal Weed Inspector (2 Positions)

Lamont County is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Weed Inspector. The Weed Inspectors will report directly to the Agricultural Fieldman. This is a seasonal position, with possibility of extension, starting from April 25, 2022, to August 31, 2022 (dates may vary based on weather).

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful applicant will be responsible for:

- Receiving and responding to weed complaints, conducting field inspections, and weed identification.
- Advising landowners of their weed control responsibilities.
- Issuing of enforcement notices as required by the Agricultural Service Board and the Weed Control Act.
- Assist with annual crop pest surveillance, including insect and crop diseases.

Qualifications:

The successful applicant shall be a student of, or a recent graduate of a post-secondary program in Environmental Sciences, Science, or Agricultural Studies from an accredited institution. The individual shall possess good communication and public relation skills. A working knowledge of weed species identification, crop pest identification, an agricultural background, and a familiarity with word processing, spreadsheet, and GIS computer software would be an asset.

All applicants must possess a valid Class 5 driver's license and provide their own reliable transportation to work. A satisfactory driver's abstract, criminal record check and a negative drug screen will be required prior to employment commencement.
