Labourer, Public Works (Seasonal)

Lamont County is seeking qualified candidates for the position of a **Seasonal Labourer** as part of the *Public Works Department*. This position reports directly to either the Operations Supervisor, or Drainage and Approach Supervisor and performs a variety of labour-intensive tasks for the 2025 road maintenance season. Preference will be given to candidates who have experience.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Manual tasks of all types in all operations (cleaning and steaming culvert ends, patching, pothole repairs, signage, guard rails, flagging, garbage and tree clean up, etc.).
- Installation of Road Crossing Culverts and Approaches (working around heavy equipment, operation of plate tamper. etc.).
- Operate a Lamont County vehicle and other light equipment, including small tractors, trailers, etc.
- Compliance with Lamont County's Health and Safety program.
- Accurate recording and submission of weekly timesheets.
- Other labour-related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Experience in labour work and operating light equipment.
